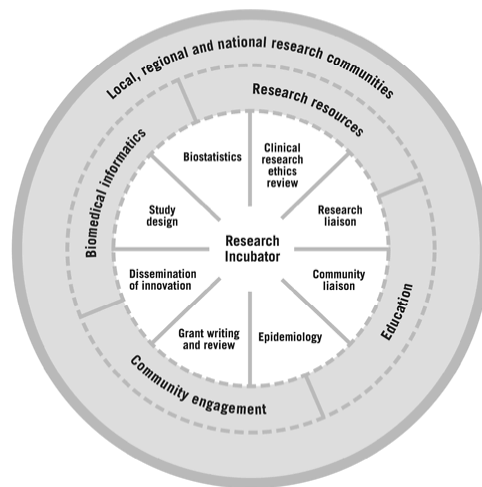

CTSA AWARD

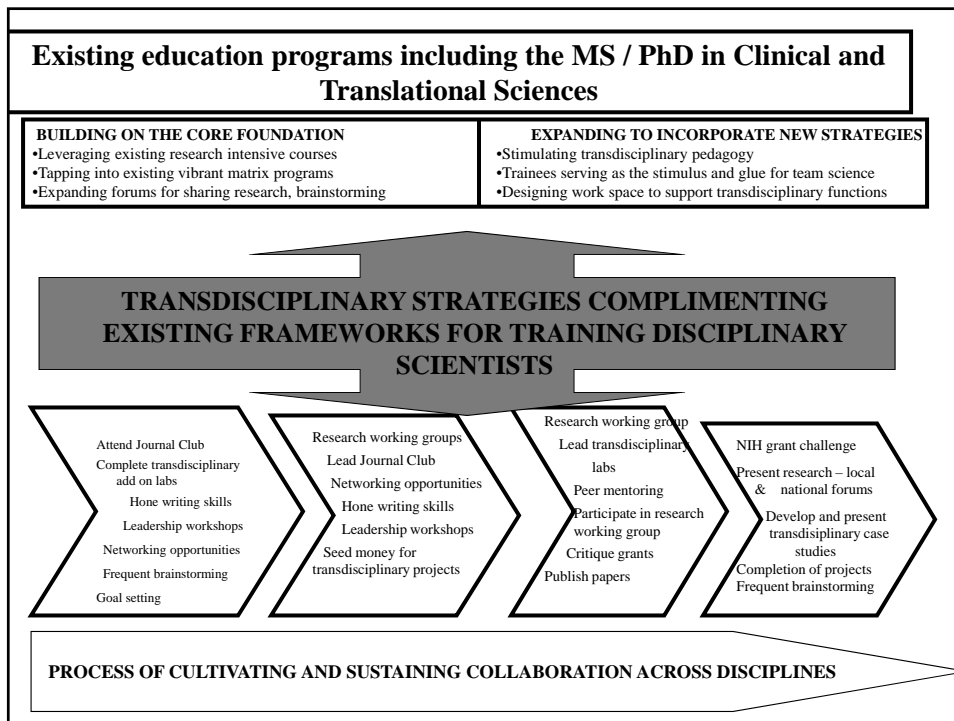
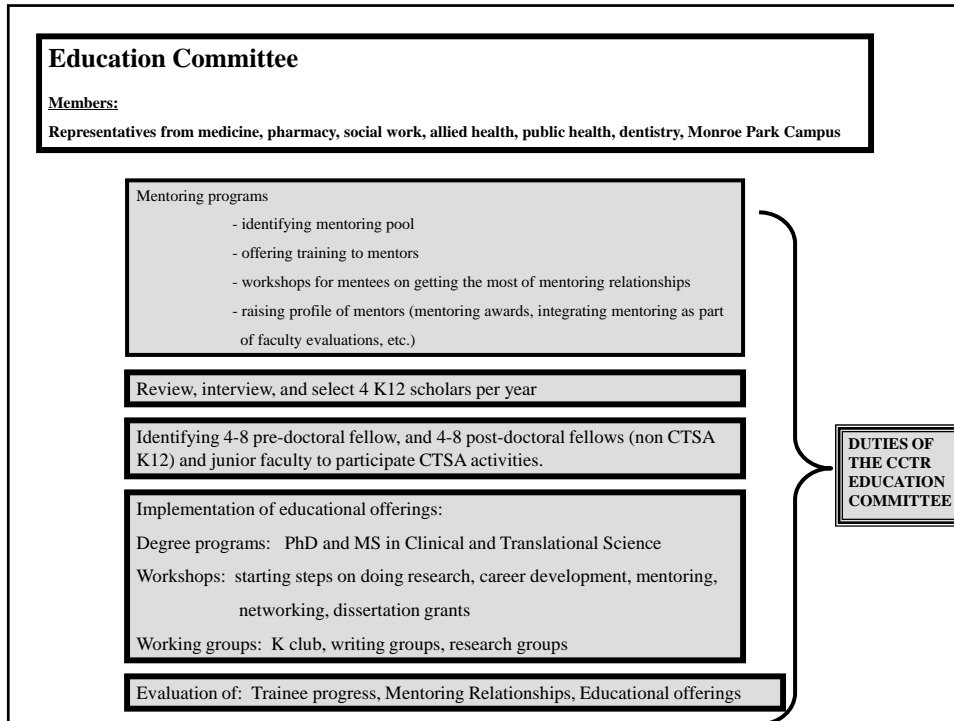
- \$20,000,000 award; 5 years
- Multidisciplinary research focus areas:
 - **substance abuse**
 - **women’s health**
 - **rehabilitation science.**
- Translational models that coalesce innovative basic investigations into research strategies that will change health outcomes in communities.
- Goal: to integrate these programs with each other and bring elements of each of these models to growing clinical/translational (C/T) programs, while supporting both established and new initiatives with infrastructure, consolidated resources and needed services.

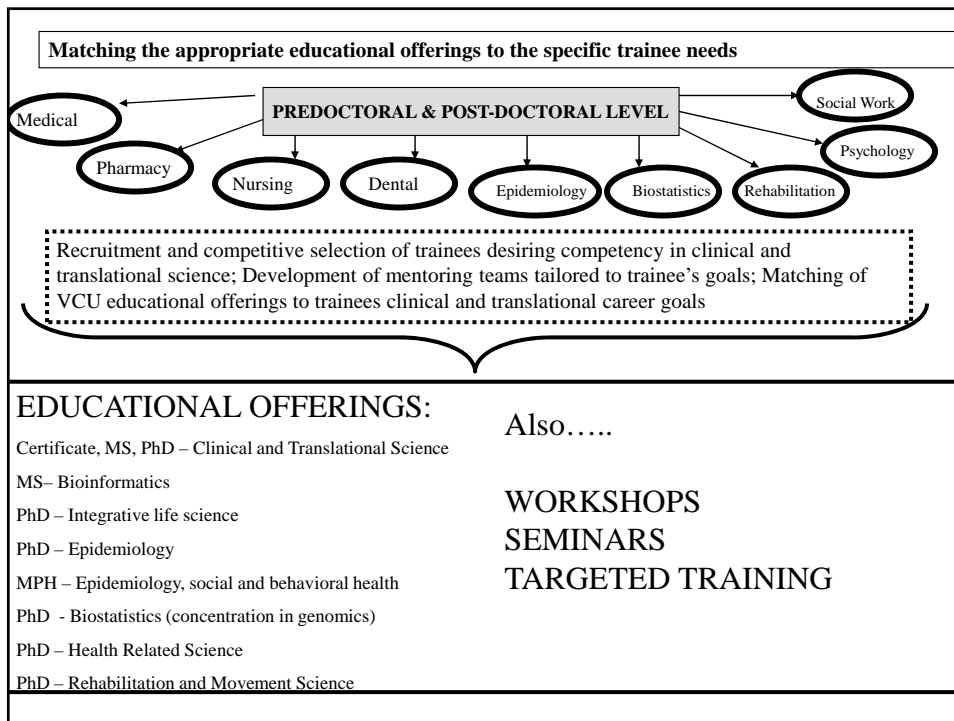
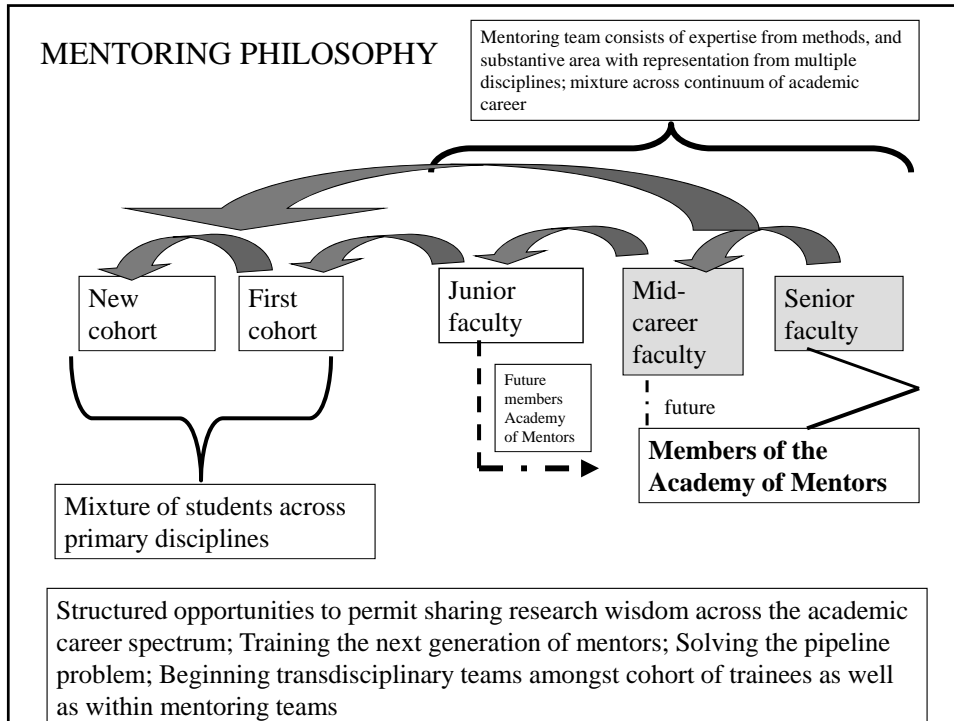

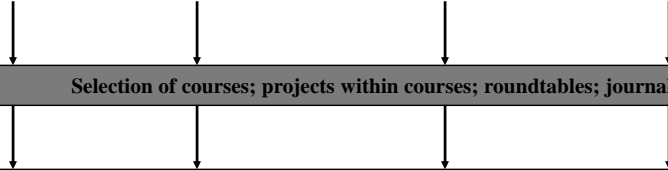
